Our training equips individuals, teams, and organisations with the skills, knowledge, and confidence to engage respectfully and effectively with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. We create a welcoming learning environment that breaks down barriers, encourages open conversation, and ensures participants feel comfortable to ask questions and explore new perspectives.

Every session is grounded in a strength-based approach, highlighting the resilience, knowledge systems, and achievements of First Nations peoples. Designed to increase cultural awareness, foster culturally safe environments, and strengthen service delivery outcomes, our training supports lasting change through understanding, respect, and collaboration.

TRAINING WORKSHOPS

We provide a variety of one-day and two-day training workshops, delivered either at our state-of-the-art Parkside facility in South Australia or at locations across Australia by request.

CUBE (*Cultural Understanding for Better Engagement*) - Build cultural awareness and practical engagement strategies to strengthen relationships and outcomes with Aboriginal communities.

TICR (*Trauma Informed, Culturally Responsive*) - Develop trauma-informed and culturally responsive skills to support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples in every day practice.

Complex Case Management - Enhance case management approaches with a strong cultural lens to improve pathways, safety, and outcomes for Aboriginal clients.

Cultural Recruitment & Retention - Gain strategies to recruit, retain, and support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander employees through culturally informed workplace practices.

Responding to Domestic & Family Violence - Learn to identify, understand, and respond effectively to Domestic, Aboriginal, Family and Sexual violence with safety-focused strategies and sensitivity.
