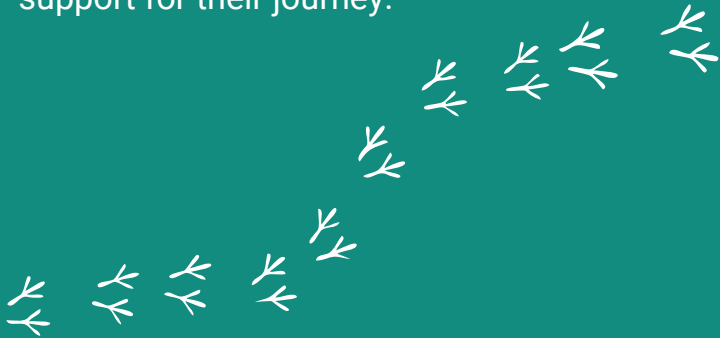
BUBs BUILDING UP BUBS



What is BUBs?

Building Up Bubs offers families flexible ways to access child development screenings. As little ones grow, they go through many exciting stages, each at their own unique pace. These stages involve not only physical changes but also the joy of learning new skills and developing socially and emotionally.

BUBs are happy to provide our service to help you understand your child's growth better and to offer the best possible support for their journey.



If you have a little one aged up to and including 5 years and they haven't had a recent child development screening, we'd love to chat with you! Feel free to reach out, and we can have a friendly discussion about your child's growth and development.

What are child development screenings?

- Child development screenings help monitor whether a child is meeting the milestones for their age (such as taking a first step, smiling and talking for the first time).
- Looking at the following areas: communication, movement, problem-solving and personal-social skills.
- Using a cross-cultural adaptation of the Ages and Stages Questionnaire (ASQ) developmental screening tool to identify Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children with possible developmental concerns.



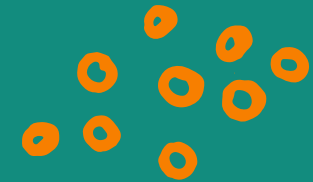
The next steps..
