Guidelines for submitting paper:

- Abstracts must be submitted online. If you are unable to complete the abstract submission electronically, please contact the Summit organisers on summit@kwy.org.au to discuss other options.
- Please submit your abstract by 15 January 2023.
- All submitted forms will be considered by the summit organisers and assessed according to the selection criteria.
- We may negotiate with you to adapt the original format of your presentation.
- Abstracts must be based on one of the themes listed below and be trauma informed and culturally responsive.
- Abstracts by collaborative groups may be accepted.
- All abstracts are for a 40-minute presentation which will be on presented on the 29th or 30th of March 2023.

The following selection criteria will apply:

- The presentation must relate directly to summit objectives and fit within one of the key summit themes, listed below.
- Preference will be given to presentations that are:
 - Presented or co-presented by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and community members.
 - From Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander organisations.
 - Evidence or outcome based (what is working).
 - Presenting something new (e.g. New research, new practices, progressive ideas, new application of culture).
 - In collaboration with other agencies or young people.

The Summit themes are:

- Healing and recovery
- Holistic and family responses
- Outside the circle - innovative responses
- Working with men who use violence against women and children
- The impacts of domestic and Aboriginal family violence on people with a disability
- The impacts of domestic and Aboriginal family violence on children and young people
