## Port Augusta Programs

---

**KWY Women's Strengths and Resilience Programs:**

**LittleSteps:** Provides group and one on one support for women who are or have experienced domestic, family and sexual violence. Empowering women to overcome trauma, grief and loss and to increase parenting knowledge.

**Healing by Art:** Creating a safe space for women to share their stories, support each other and feel empowered.

**Other KWY Programs Include:**

**Parents NextProvider:** Supporting individuals referred by Centerlink who are required to participate in the Parents Next program as part of their mutual obligation requirements. KWY staff support and refer participants to meet their education and employment goals.

**KWY's Mens Behaviour Change Program:** My Journey is a culturally appropriate behaviour change program for men who use violence. KWY provides a culturally safe space to address family, domestic and sexual violence.
